Summary

SB2847 amends the Criminal Code of 2012 to include false personation using artificial intelligence, defining 'artificial intelligence'.

Business Impact

If you use AI for identity representation, ensure compliance with new definitions to avoid legal issues.

Key Provisions

- Amends the Criminal Code of 2012 (720 ILCS 5/17-0.5, 720 ILCS 5/17-2).
- Defines 'artificial intelligence' (Sec. 17-0.5).
- Addresses false personation using artificial intelligence (Sec. 17-2).

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure AI applications do not facilitate false personation. | Who: Businesses and individuals using AI technologies. | Penalty: Potential criminal charges or fines.
