The bill aims to create oversight for developers and deployers of inherently dangerous AI systems in Vermont.

Business Impact

If you develop or deploy AI systems in Vermont, you must comply with new safety standards or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Establishes oversight for inherently dangerous AI systems.
- Aims to mandate safety standards for developers and deployers.
- Mentions compliance requirements needing further detail verification.
