Effective: Oct 01, 2023 | Last Action (Aug 13, 2021): Public Act 102-0354

Summary

The bill prohibits the Secretary of State from providing facial recognition services to law enforcement for immigration enforcement.

Business Impact

If you operate in Illinois and use facial recognition technology, you must ensure it is not used for immigration enforcement or face legal consequences.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits the Secretary of State from providing facial recognition services for immigration enforcement.
- Allows facial recognition requests for criminal investigations unrelated to immigration laws.
- Amends the Illinois Identification Card Act and the Illinois Vehicle Code.
- Effective immediately upon becoming law.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure facial recognition technology is not used for immigration enforcement. | Who: Law enforcement agencies and governmental entities. | Penalty: Potential legal challenges or operational restrictions.
