Last Action (Aug 15, 2025): Public Act 104-0322

Summary

Hospitals must confirm diagnostic algorithms are certified and accurate before use, and patients must consent to their use.

Business Impact

If you operate a hospital in Illinois, you must ensure diagnostic algorithms are certified and obtain patient consent before use.

Key Provisions

- Hospitals must confirm diagnostic algorithms are certified by relevant state departments.
- Algorithms must show equal or greater accuracy compared to other diagnostic methods.
- Patients must be informed about the use of diagnostic algorithms.
- Patients must have the option to decline the use of diagnostic algorithms.
- The algorithm cannot be the only diagnostic method available.

Compliance Checklist

- Confirm certification of diagnostic algorithms | Who: Hospitals | Penalty: Potential regulatory penalties for non-compliance
- Obtain patient consent before using diagnostic algorithms | Who: Hospitals | Penalty: Potential regulatory penalties for non-compliance
