SOS-FACIAL RECOGNITION TECH

Summary

This bill prohibits the Secretary of State from providing facial recognition services or related photographs to law enforcement for law enforcement purposes.

Business Impact

If you operate in Illinois and use facial recognition technology, you must ensure compliance with this prohibition to avoid legal repercussions.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits the Secretary of State from providing facial recognition services to law enforcement.
- Applies to all federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies.
- Amends the Illinois Identification Card Act and the Illinois Vehicle Code.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure no facial recognition data is shared with law enforcement agencies. | Who: Secretary of State and associated personnel. | Penalty: Legal repercussions for unauthorized data sharing.
