Summary

HB1047 allows expired child sexual abuse claims against certain entities in bankruptcy until July 1, 2025, and defines AI-generated images as intimate images.

Business Impact

If you distribute AI-generated images, ensure compliance with new intimate image laws by July 2025 to avoid legal issues.

Key Provisions

- Allows expired child sexual abuse claims against entities in bankruptcy until July 1, 2025.
- Defines AI-generated images as 'intimate images' for legal purposes.
- Exempts certain news media and internet service providers from criminal liability under specified conditions.
- Expands 'peep' in the voyeurism statute to include concealed cameras.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure consent is obtained for AI-generated intimate images. | Who: Content creators and distributors. | Penalty: Potential legal action for non-compliance.
- Review and update policies regarding the distribution of intimate images. | Who: Businesses involved in media and content distribution. | Penalty: Liability under nonconsensual pornography laws.
