Risk: Medium

Narrow/Targeted

Last Action (Jan 19, 2023): First reading: referred to Committee on Roads and Transportation

Summary

The bill prohibits airport authorities in Indiana from using facial recognition systems in their facilities.

Business Impact

If you operate an airport in Indiana, you must not implement facial recognition systems in your facilities.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits the use of facial recognition systems by airport authorities.
- Applies to facilities under the jurisdiction of aviation boards.
