## Use of facial recognition software.

Introduced

Risk: Medium

Narrow/Targeted

Last Action (Jan 19, 2023): First reading: referred to Committee on Roads and Transportation

## Summary

The bill prohibits airport authorities in Indiana from using facial recognition systems in their facilities.

## Business Impact

If you operate an airport facility in Indiana, you must not implement facial recognition systems or face potential legal challenges.

## Key Provisions

- Prohibits the use of facial recognition systems by airport authorities.
- Applies to all facilities under the jurisdiction of the authority or board.
- Reflects growing concerns over privacy and surveillance.

## Compliance Checklist

- Cease any plans to implement facial recognition systems | Who: Airport authorities and boards of aviation commissioners | Penalty: Potential legal challenges
