Summary

SB2164, introduced in the U.S. Senate, directs the FTC to require impact assessments of automated decision systems and develop guidelines, focusing on critical decision processes.

Business Impact

If you use AI for automated decision-making, you must conduct impact assessments by January 2026 or face penalties from the FTC.

Key Provisions

- Directs the FTC to require impact assessments of automated decision systems.
- Addresses critical decision processes affecting legal rights or access to resources.
- Tasks the FTC with developing guidelines for these assessments.

Compliance Checklist

- Conduct impact assessments for automated decision systems | Who: Organizations utilizing automated decision systems | Penalty: To be determined by FTC regulations
- Submit findings of impact assessments to the FTC | Who: Organizations required to comply | Penalty: To be determined by FTC regulations
