AN ACT relating to school governance.

Summary

SB131 amends school governance laws in Kentucky, changing the vote requirements for superintendent removal and board member training.

Business Impact

If you sponsor election communications using synthetic media, ensure disclosures or face potential liability immediately.

Key Provisions

- Define 'electioneering communication', 'information content provider', 'interactive computer service', 'sponsor', and 'synthetic media' (KRS 117.001)
- Establish a cause of action for the use of synthetic media in electioneering communications
- Provide an affirmative defense if the communication includes a conspicuous disclosure
- Specify that the sponsor may be held liable, but the medium is not liable except in certain circumstances
- Declare an emergency

Compliance Checklist

- Include conspicuous disclosure in electioneering communications using synthetic media. | Who: Sponsors of election communications | Penalty: Liability for misleading communications
