## Summary

The bill establishes an Artificial Intelligence Task Force to study AI's impact on Kentucky government and consumer protection by December 2024.

## Business Impact

If you operate a Kentucky government agency, you must prepare for potential changes in procurement policies related to AI by December 2024.

## Key Provisions

- Establishment of the Artificial Intelligence Task Force
- Task force to study AI's impact on government operations and procurement policies
- Recommendations for consumer protection in private and public sectors
- Task force to meet at least three times before submitting findings
- Findings and recommendations due by December 1, 2024
- Legislative Research Commission may assign issues to appropriate committees
