Mandates a study on AI use in Maryland schools and requires regulations by June 2025.

- Conduct a comprehensive study on AI use in public schools.
- Evaluate best practices for safe and ethical AI use.
- Report study results by December 1, 2024.
- Adopt regulations based on study by June 1, 2025.
