Summary

The bill mandates a study on AI use in public schools, evaluating best practices for ethical applications and data protection.

Business Impact

If you operate a public school in Maryland, you must prepare for new AI regulations by June 1, 2025, or face compliance issues.

Key Provisions

- Requires a comprehensive study on AI use in public schools.
- Evaluates best practices for ethical AI applications.
- Focuses on protecting personal information of students and personnel.
- Mandates a report to the Governor and General Assembly by December 1, 2024.
- Requires regulations to be adopted by June 1, 2025.
