Summary

The bill mandates the Maryland State Department of Education to create AI guidelines and a pilot program for county boards of education.

Business Impact

If you operate a county board of education in Maryland, you must implement AI guidelines by July 1, 2024, or face potential compliance issues.

Key Provisions

- The State Department of Education must develop AI guidelines for county boards.
- A pilot program will be established to support the AI Subcabinet.
- Strategies will be created to assist county boards in integrating AI into educational standards.
