Summary

This bill establishes the Artificial Intelligence Impact Advisory Board to study AI-related issues and report findings annually to the Governor and General Assembly.

Business Impact

If you operate in Maryland and are involved with AI technologies, you must stay informed about the Board's findings and recommendations starting in 2024.

Key Provisions

- Establishment of the Artificial Intelligence Impact Advisory Board.
- Board to study issues related to AI and its impact on citizens.
- Annual reporting of findings and recommendations to the Governor and General Assembly by December 31.

Compliance Checklist

- Engage with the Artificial Intelligence Impact Advisory Board's findings | Who: Businesses and stakeholders involved with AI in Maryland | Penalty: No specified penalties, but non-engagement may lead to unpreparedness for future regulations.
