Summary

Establishes a commission to study AI use and regulation in Maryland, with the Governor designating the chair and staff support from the Department of Legislative Services.

Business Impact

If you operate AI in Maryland, expect new regulations by June 2025.

Key Provisions

- Establishes a Commission on Responsible Artificial Intelligence in Maryland.
- Commission to study AI definitions and regulatory alignment.
- Commission to report findings by June 30, 2025.
- Includes members from government, industry, and academia.
- Develops best practices for public sector AI use.
- Recommends oversight and infrastructure for AI.
- Governor designates the chair of the Commission.
- Department of Legislative Services provides staff for the Commission.
