Summary

This bill establishes how controllers and processors can handle consumer personal data and regulates biometric data usage.

Business Impact

If you process consumer data in Maryland, you must implement methods for consumers to exercise their data rights or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Establishes how controllers/processors may process consumer personal data.
- Grants consumers rights regarding their personal data.
- Requires controllers to provide methods for consumers to exercise their rights.
- Regulates the use of biometric data by controllers.

- Ensure compliance with biometric data regulations | Who: Data controllers | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance
