Summary

The Meaningful Human Review of AI Act requires state agencies using automated decision-making systems to have continuous human review and mandates impact assessments with detailed evaluations submitted to the Governor and General Assembly.

Business Impact

If you operate a state agency using AI for decision-making, you must implement continuous human review and impact assessments by January 2025 or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits state agencies from using automated decision-making systems without continuous human review.
- Requires impact assessments for any automated decision-making system used by state agencies to be submitted to the Governor and General Assembly.
- Impact assessments must include a description and evaluation of the objectives and development of the system, testing, and notification mechanisms for impacted individuals.

Compliance Checklist

- Conduct impact assessments for automated decision-making systems. | Who: State agencies utilizing such systems. | Penalty: Cease utilization of the system if discriminatory outcomes are found.
- Submit impact assessments to the Governor and General Assembly. | Who: State agencies. | Penalty: Potential delays in implementation of the automated decision-making system.
