## Relative to event data recorders in autonomous vehicles

Introduced

Risk: Medium

Sector-Specific

Last Action (Oct 08, 2020): Accompanied a study order, see H5028

## Summary

This bill addresses autonomous vehicles but does not specify regulations for event data recorders.

## Business Impact

If you operate autonomous vehicles in Massachusetts, you must ensure compliance with event data recorder regulations or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Mandates the installation of event data recorders in autonomous vehicles.
- Requires recording of critical operational data during vehicle operation.
- Ensures data accessibility for safety analysis post-incident.

## Compliance Checklist

- Install event data recorders in all autonomous vehicles. | Who: Manufacturers and operators of autonomous vehicles. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance may apply.
