Summary

This bill requires facial recognition technology to be used in the application process for driver's licenses and Minnesota identification cards.

Business Impact

If you process driver's license applications in Minnesota, you must implement facial recognition technology by the effective date or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Facial recognition technology is required for driver's license applications.
- Facial recognition technology is required for Minnesota identification card applications.
