## Summary

SF129 prohibits Minnesota government entities from acquiring or using facial recognition technology.

## Business Impact

If you provide facial recognition technology to government entities in Minnesota, you must cease operations immediately.

## Key Provisions

- Prohibits government entities from acquiring facial recognition technology.
- Prohibits government entities from using facial recognition technology.

## Compliance Checklist

- Cease all use of facial recognition technology | Who: All government entities in Minnesota | Penalty: Legal challenges or other unspecified consequences
