Summary

This bill establishes a cause of action for the nonconsensual dissemination of deep fake sexual images in Minnesota.

Business Impact

If you create or share digital content in Minnesota, you must ensure consent for any deep fake images or face legal action.

Key Provisions

- Establishes a cause of action for victims of nonconsensual deep fake sexual images.
- Allows victims to seek damages in civil court.

Compliance Checklist

- Obtain explicit consent from individuals before creating or sharing deep fake images. | Who: Content creators and distributors. | Penalty: Potential civil liability for damages.
- Implement policies to ensure compliance with consent requirements. | Who: Businesses and platforms utilizing AI-generated content. | Penalty: Legal action from affected individuals.
