Artificial Intelligence Task Force; create and prescribe responsibilities of.

Summary

The bill creates the Artificial Intelligence Regulation Task Force to study AI applications, risks, and policy recommendations, reporting annually to the legislature.

Business Impact

If you develop or use AI technologies in Mississippi, you must stay informed about the task force's findings and recommendations by December 1 each year.

Key Provisions

- Establishes the Artificial Intelligence Regulation Task Force.
- Task force to consist of seven voting members and may appoint ex-officio advisory members.
- Requires annual reporting of findings and recommendations to the legislature.
- Task force to evaluate AI applications and risks, balancing innovation with public interest.
- Members receive per diem and travel reimbursement for official business.
- Task force authorized to accept funding.
