Revises provisions relating to transportation network companies. (BDR 58-935)

Last Action (Jun 11, 2021): Chapter 550.

Summary

SB288 allows agreements between monitored autonomous vehicle providers and TNCs for service provision and prohibits local taxes on these services.

Business Impact

If you operate a TNC in Nevada, you must comply with new service provision rules or face operational restrictions.

Key Provisions

- Authorizes agreements between monitored autonomous vehicle providers and TNCs for service provision.
- Prohibits local governments from imposing certain taxes or fees on these services.
