Summary

HB1688 prohibits New Hampshire state agencies from using AI for manipulation, discrimination, or surveillance.

Business Impact

If you use AI in state contracts, ensure compliance by April 1, 2025, or face removal of non-compliant systems.

Key Provisions

- 5-D:3 Prohibition on AI use for manipulation, discrimination, or surveillance
- 5-D:4 Permitted uses and restrictions on AI
- 5-D:5 Compliance requirements for state agencies
