Summary

HB1710 establishes a civil cause of action for the distribution of misleading synthetic media in New Hampshire.

Business Impact

If you distribute synthetic media, ensure compliance with disclosure requirements by July 1, 2024, or face legal action.

- 14-c - Use of Synthetic Media in Political Communications
