Business Impact

Key Provisions

- Conduct a study on AI's impact on the state's economy.
- Focus on highly-skilled and educated professions.
- Report findings to the Governor and Legislature within one year.
- Consult with the New Jersey Commission on Science, Innovation and Technology.
- Identify new professions emerging from AI advancements.
- Assess AI's impact on labor productivity and economic growth.
