Prohibits deepfake pornography and imposes criminal and civil penalties for non-consensual disclosure.

## Summary

This bill aims to establish penalties for non-consensual disclosure of deepfake pornography, but specifics cannot be confirmed without the full bill text.

If you create or distribute digital content in New Jersey, you must ensure it does not involve non-consensual deepfake pornography or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Aims to establish criminal penalties for non-consensual disclosure of deepfake content.
- Seeks to establish civil penalties for individuals harmed by deepfake pornography.
- The bill's aim is based on the title and official description, without additional interpretations.

## Compliance Checklist

- Ensure all digital content does not involve non-consensual deepfake pornography. | Who: Content creators and distributors. | Penalty: Fines and potential imprisonment.
- Obtain explicit consent from individuals depicted in any deepfake content. | Who: Content creators. | Penalty: Civil penalties for non-compliance.
