Key Provisions

- Establishes a Deepfake Technology Unit in the Division of Criminal Justice.
- Appropriates \$2 million for the unit's operations.
- Provides technical assistance and training to law enforcement and courts.
- Analyzes and authenticates deepfake media evidence.
- Issues annual reports on unit activities and technological advancements.
