## Business Impact

If you are a nonprofit in NJ, apply for grants to fund AI security systems.

## Key Provisions

- Establishes a grant program for nonprofits to implement AI and smart tech.
- Grants up to \$100,000 for AI systems and \$25,000 for smart tech.
- Prioritizes nonprofits serving at-risk and diverse communities.
- Requires annual budget requests of at least \$14 million.
- Mandates community engagement and regular reporting by recipients.
