## Summary

This bill mandates a study by the Commission on Science, Innovation and Technology on the impact of AI in State agencies.

## Business Impact

If your agency uses AI technology, you must prepare for a study on its impact by May 2025 or face potential scrutiny.

## Key Provisions

- The Commission on Science, Innovation and Technology must study the impact of AI in State agencies.
- The study will include a list of agencies using AI and their purposes.
- A report detailing findings must be submitted to the Governor and Legislature within one year.

## Compliance Checklist

- Prepare for the Commission's study on AI impact. | Who: State agencies using AI technology. | Penalty: Potential scrutiny from the Commission.
