Summary

The bill establishes the New Jersey Artificial Intelligence Advisory Council to study AI's impact on state agencies, develop ethical guidelines, and support AI strategies.

Business Impact

If you operate a state agency in New Jersey, you must prepare for potential new ethical guidelines on AI use by next year or face compliance issues.

Key Provisions

- Establishes the New Jersey Artificial Intelligence Advisory Council.
- Council to assess the need for a state code of ethics for AI.
- Recommends guidelines for safe and ethical AI procurement and implementation.
- Develops strategies to deliver and support AI and other similar emerging technologies.
- Reviews automated decision systems for ethical concerns.
- Issues a report to the Governor and Legislature within one year.
- Council expires upon submission of its report.
