New Jersey requires school boards to adopt policies on AI-enabled surveillance systems.

Business Impact

If you operate AI surveillance in schools, you must adopt a policy by the next school year or face non-compliance.

Key Provisions

- Boards must adopt a policy on AI surveillance systems.
- Policy must include information on the system and data use.
- Signage indicating AI surveillance must be posted.
