Summary

Mandates AI instruction in K-12 and AI curricula in higher education in NJ.

Business Impact

If you operate a public school or college in NJ, you must implement AI curricula by the next academic year.

Key Provisions

- K-12 schools must include AI instruction in curricula.
- Public colleges must offer AI certificate and degree programs.
- Secretary of Higher Education to develop AI model curricula.
- AI curricula must meet accreditation standards.
- AI career pathway materials to be developed and distributed.
