Business Impact

If you sell AI tech in NJ, you must conduct an AI impact assessment annually.

Key Provisions

- Establishes the Artificial Intelligence Ethics Board in NJ DOLWD.
- Requires AI impact assessments before selling AI tech in NJ.
- Focuses on bias prevention, privacy, and accountability.
- Recommends worker protections against AI-induced displacement.
- Defines 'artificial intelligence' and 'AI impact assessment'.
- Board to adopt rules under the Administrative Procedure Act.
