Summary

The bill establishes an AI Grant Program in New Jersey's Office of the Secretary of Higher Education to fund nonprofit AI education and training.

Business Impact

If you operate a nonprofit providing AI education, apply for grants up to \$25,000 annually.

Key Provisions

- Establishes the Artificial Intelligence Grant Program in the Office of the Secretary of Higher Education (Section 1a).
- Nonprofit entities must apply and demonstrate comprehensive AI education programs (Section 1b-c).
- Secretary considers specific factors for grant awards (Section 1d).
- Annually selects four nonprofits for grants up to \$25,000 each (Section 1e).
- Creates the 'Artificial Intelligence Education Fund' (Section 3a).
