The bill mandates the NJ Attorney General to study AI use in police report generation and issue a report within six months.

Business Impact

Key Provisions

- Section 1(a): Requires the Attorney General to study AI use in generating police reports.
- Section 1(b)(1): Assessment of available AI technology and feasibility.
- Section 1(b)(2): Statewide summary of current AI use in police reports.
- Section 1(b)(3): Recommendations for a Statewide policy on AI use.
