Last Action (Jan 09, 2024): Introduced in the Senate, Referred to Senate State Government, Wagering, Tourism & Historic Preservation Committee

Summary

Regulates AI and automated systems used by NJ State agencies, establishing oversight roles and procedures.

Business Impact

If you develop AI for NJ State agencies, you must comply with new procedures by 2025 or face operational restrictions.

Key Provisions

- Appointment of an Artificial Intelligence Officer within six months.
- Development of automated systems procedures for State agencies.
- Biennial review of compliance with automated systems procedures.
- Safeguards against discrimination and unlawful impacts.
- Transparency and traceability of AI systems.
- Deactivation of non-compliant AI systems.

Compliance Checklist

- Appoint an Artificial Intelligence Officer | Who: Chief Technology Officer of NJ | Penalty: Operational restrictions on non-compliance
- Develop and adopt automated systems procedures | Who: Artificial Intelligence Officer | Penalty: Operational restrictions on non-compliance
- Review AI systems for compliance | Who: State agencies | Penalty: Deactivation of non-compliant systems
