## Summary

Mandates AI instruction in K-12 and AI programs in higher education in New Jersey.

## Business Impact

If you operate a public school or college in NJ, you must implement AI curricula by the next academic year.

## Key Provisions

- K-12 schools must include AI instruction in curricula.
- Public colleges must offer AI certificate and degree programs.
- Development of AI model curricula for higher education.
- AI career pathway marketing materials to be distributed.
- Immediate effect with application in the next full school year.
