Concerns regulation of automated systems and artificial intelligence used by State agencies.

Last Action (May 22, 2023): Introduced in the Senate, Referred to Senate State Government, Wagering, Tourism & Historic Preservation Committee

Summary

This bill regulates the use of automated systems and AI by New Jersey State agencies, establishing oversight and compliance procedures.

Business Impact

If you operate a State agency in New Jersey using AI, you must comply with new automated systems procedures by the effective date or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Establishes the role of an Artificial Intelligence Officer to oversee AI use in State agencies.
- Mandates development of automated systems procedures within six months after the appointment of the Artificial Intelligence Officer and updates every two years.
- Imposes safeguards to ensure compliance with legal and ethical standards.
- Ensures public transparency regarding the use of automated systems.
- Allows for third-party assistance in developing compliance procedures.

Compliance Checklist

- Appoint an Artificial Intelligence Officer | Who: Chief Technology Officer of the Office of Information Technology | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance not specified
- Develop and adopt automated systems procedures | Who: Artificial Intelligence Officer | Penalty: No State agency may use automated systems without compliance
- Conduct an inventory of automated systems | Who: Each State agency | Penalty: Public disclosure of non-compliance
