Establishes partnerships for AI job training in New Jersey, with advisory council membership at the commissioner's discretion.

If you develop AI training programs in NJ, you can partner with the state without procurement constraints.

## Key Provisions

- Establishes public-private partnerships for AI job training.
- Exempts private entities from procurement and wage requirements.
- Requires annual reporting to the Governor and Legislature.
- Creates an advisory council to guide partnerships, with membership at the commissioner's discretion.
- Allows remote delivery of training programs.
