Summary

This bill mandates a study by the Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development on AI's impact on New Jersey's economy, detailing scope and methodology, with no specified deadline for the report.

Business Impact

Key Provisions

- Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development must conduct a study.
- The study will focus on the impact of AI on the state's economy, including specified scope and methodology.
- A report summarizing the findings must be issued, with no specified deadline.
- Collaboration with relevant departments and stakeholders is required.
