### Summary

Requires a public hearing before law enforcement can use facial recognition technology in New Jersey.

### Business Impact

If you use facial recognition technology in law enforcement, you must hold a public hearing before use.

### Key Provisions

- Section 1(a): Public hearing required before use of facial recognition technology.
- Section 1(b): Hearing within 60 days if technology is already in use.
- Section 1(c): Follow-up hearing five years after initial hearing.
- Section 1(d): Definition of 'facial recognition technology'.
