Extends crime of identity theft to include fraudulent impersonation or false depiction by means of artificial intelligence or deepfake technology.

## Summary

Requires county prosecutors to track sexual assault forensic evidence kits.

## Business Impact

If you handle SAFE kits in NJ, establish a tracking system by the fourth month after enactment.

## Key Provisions

- County prosecutors must establish a centralized tracking system for SAFE kits.
- Tracking systems must meet requirements set by the Attorney General.
- The Attorney General will issue guidelines to implement the bill.
