Requires Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development to conduct study and issue report on impact of artificial intelligence on growth of State's economy.

Summary

This bill mandates a study on the impact of artificial intelligence on New Jersey's economy, focusing on labor market changes and new professions.

Business Impact

If you operate in New Jersey, you must prepare for potential changes in workforce dynamics due to AI by the report's submission date.

Key Provisions

- Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development to conduct a study on AI's economic impact.
- Report to be submitted within one year of the bill's effective date.
- Study to include predictions on labor market impacts and new professions.
- Consultation with the New Jersey Commission on Science, Innovation and Technology.
- Report to be shared with the Governor and relevant legislative committees.
