

# A2807 • New Jersey

Prohibits four-year public and independent institutions of higher education from increasing New Jersey resident undergraduate tuition and fees for nine continuous semesters following student's initial enrollment.\*

## Summary

This bill prohibits tuition and fee increases for New Jersey resident undergraduates for nine semesters after initial enrollment.

## Business Impact

If you operate autonomous vehicles in New Jersey, you must ensure law enforcement is trained to interact with them by December 31, 2020.

## Key Provisions

- The Attorney General must develop a training course for law enforcement on interacting with autonomous vehicles.
- All law enforcement officers must complete the training by December 31, 2020.
- Individuals must complete the training before being appointed to permanent status as law enforcement officers.
- The Police Training Commission will adopt rules to implement the training program.
- The curriculum will be reviewed every five years by the Attorney General and modified as necessary.
- An 'autonomous vehicle' is defined as one that operates without human control.

## Compliance Checklist

- Complete the training course on autonomous vehicle interaction | Who: All law enforcement officers | Penalty: Non-compliance may affect appointment status or operational readiness.
- Ensure new law enforcement recruits complete the training before permanent appointment | Who: Law enforcement agencies | Penalty: Failure to comply may result in unqualified personnel.
