Restricts governmental use of facial and biometric recognition technology in New Jersey.

Business Impact

If you provide biometric tech to NJ government, ensure compliance with new restrictions or face legal challenges.

Key Provisions

- Section 3(a): Prohibition on use of biometric systems by governmental entities.
- Section 3(b): Conditions for permissible use of biometric systems.
- Section 3(c): Inadmissibility of improperly obtained biometric information.
- Section 3(d): Legal remedies for violations.
- Section 3(e): Disciplinary actions for violating officials.
