Requires public hearing prior to use of facial recognition technology by law enforcement agency.

Introduced

Risk: Low

Narrow/Targeted

Last Action (Feb 25, 2020): Introduced in the Senate, Referred to Senate Law and Public Safety Committee

Summary

Allows autism diagnosis to be noted on NJ driver's licenses for law enforcement communication.

Business Impact

If you operate in NJ, ensure autism info is included in vehicle records by the effective date.

Key Provisions

- Establishes a program for autism diagnosis reporting in motor vehicle records.
- Information is for law enforcement use during stops.
- Data is not a public record and not subject to disclosure.
