Prohibits certain discrimination by automated decision systems.

Summary

Requires insurance coverage for medical cannabis under certain conditions for qualifying patients.

Business Impact

If you provide insurance in NJ, you must cover medical cannabis costs unless federal law intervenes.

Key Provisions

- Mandates insurance coverage for medical cannabis costs for qualifying patients.
- Exempts insurers from coverage if federal law intervenes.
- Requires direct reimbursement to patients if dispensary payment is not feasible.

Compliance Checklist
