Summary

This bill creates a temporary commission to study the regulation of artificial intelligence, robotics, and automation in New York.

Business Impact

If you operate in AI or automation in New York, you must stay informed about potential regulations from the commission by December 31, 2024.

Key Provisions

- Establishes a temporary commission to study AI, robotics, and automation regulation.
- Commission to consist of thirteen members appointed by state officials.
- Commission to issue a final report by December 31, 2024.
- Study includes AI in weaponry and public sector applications.

Compliance Checklist

- Stay informed about the commission's findings and recommendations. | Who: Businesses operating in AI and automation in New York. | Penalty: No specific penalties outlined, but non-compliance may affect business operations.
